

STIPENDIARY STEWARDS REPORT

CALCUTTA RACES

WINTER MEETING, SECOND DAY, TUESDAY, 8th JANUARY, 2019

Penetrometer Reading 1.3 Cms

False rails were in position from about 1200 metres to about 400 metres.

1st RACE (81) THE AREONATIVE HANDICAP – For Horses Rated 1-26 (About) 2000 Metres (12.30/12.32) : 8 runners

SOLARIS (Ranidan Singh) was slow to begin.

Jockey Neeraj Rawal, the rider of WINNER'S DELIGHT, reported that his mount was inclined to hang 'out' throughout the race.

Jockey Ranidan Singh, the rider of SOLARIS dropped his whip passing the distance post.

2nd RACE (82) THE PRINCE BLOSSOM PLATE – For Maiden Horses 3 years old only (About) 1400 Metres (1.00/1.04) : 6 runners

GAURISH (Nikhil Naidu) was fractious while being stalled.

Jockey Neeraj Rawal, the rider of b f SHIVALIK SIGHT, reported that he was unable to get a clear run during the final 400 metres of the race.

An enquiry has been opened into the running and riding of b f SHIVALIK SIGHT, trained by Mr. Vijay Singh and ridden by Jockey Neeraj Rawal.

3rd RACE (83) THE AAZISH HANDICAP – For Horses Rated 41-66, Rated 21-46 eligible (About) 1600 Metres (1.30/1.35) : 6 runners

ALYSSA (Neeraj Rawal) arrived late to the start thereby delaying the proceedings of the race. Tr. Vijay Singh was advised to ensure that his charge arrives on time in future.

4th RACE (84) THE ZARASHAH HANDICAP – For Horses Rated 21-46, Rated 1-26 eligible – To be ridden by Jockeys of Indian Nationality (About) 1600 Metres (2.00/2.02) : 11 runners

SEVENTH STEP (App R S Bhati) was fractious while being stalled.

RUSTLER (Hindu Singh) planted losing considerable ground at the start. The Starting Stall Certificate has been revoked by the Starter.

When afforded an opportunity to explain the improved performance of his charge b g BAMBINI FESTA (I Khan) as compared to its previous runs, Tr. Javed Khan stated that :-

- a) The gelding had not performed up to mark during the hot weather period as it was an extremely dry coated animal.
- b) The present cool climatic conditions is more conducive for a better performance, hence he accepted the gelding to run in a 1600 metres race which is more suited to the animal.
- c) The gelding was not fancied by the stable considering its previous poor performances.
- d) Other than this he could give no other plausible explanation for the improved performance.

The Stipendiary Stewards taking into account the gelding's previous running records decided to take no further action on this occasion other than noting his explanations. However, Trainer Mr. Javed Khan was advised to ensure that the gelding performs with a degree of consistency.

The Veterinary Officer reported that I TOLD YOU KNOW returned bleeding from both nostrils. Tr. J E Mckeown was informed not to accept with his charge until certified fit by the Veterinary Officer.

5th RACE (85) THE M B MEDHORA CUP – A Handicap for Horses Rated 61-86, Rated 41-66 eligible (About) 2000 Metres (2.30/2.31) : 7 runners

ALLDERO (Dashrath Singh) and AVARUA (Hindu Singh) were fractious while being stalled.

DROGO (Md Imran) was slow to begin.

6th RACE (86) THE ICELANDIC HANDICAP – For Horses Rated 41-66, Rated 21-46 eligible – To be ridden by Jockeys of Indian Nationality (About) 1200 Metres (3.00/3.02) : 12 runners

TIBERON (Hindu Singh) was fractious while being stalled.

BANG BANG (App P Vikram) was slow to begin.

App P Vikram, the rider of BANG BANG, reported that his mount was hanging 'out' throughout the race. However, the apprentice was cautioned for tender handling of his mount during the race.

7th RACE (87) THE ALAMEDA HANDICAP Div I – For Horses Rated 21-46, Rated 1-26 eligible – To be ridden by Jockeys of Indian Nationality (About) 1100 Metres (3.30/3.31) : 11 runners

FABIOLA (Hindu Singh) was fractious while being stalled.

JORELL (Vinay Jaiswal) was slow to begin.

Some distance after the start SCARLET EMPEROR (App Sujit Kumar Paswan) was severely checked by its Jockey when MOIRA (Afzal Khan) was carried 'inwards' by GIMME CREDIT (App P Tejeshwar). At a subsequent enquiry App P Tejeshwar was shown the CCTV replay of the race and fined a sum of Rs. 2,500/- for coming 'in' sharply when not adequately clear of the other runners.

8th RACE (88) THE ALAMEDA HANDICAP Div II – For Horses Rated 21-46, Rated 1-26 eligible – To be ridden by Jockeys of Indian Nationality (About) 1100 Metres (4.00/4.02) : 11 runners

MY LADY LUCK (Vinay Jaiswal) was slow to begin losing approximately two lengths at the start.

Jockey Ajeet Kumar, the rider of DANCING PRINCE, was reprimanded for the tender handling of his mount during the final 400 metres of the race.

At the conclusion of the enquiry it could not be conclusively established that any other rider/horse had caused Jockey P S Chouhan, the rider of EASTERN CROWN, to check his mount passing the 800 metres. Under the circumstances the Stipendiary Stewards decided to close the enquiry.
