SUMMER MEETING, SIXTH DAY, SATURDAY, 30th MARCH, 2019

No false rails

1st RACE (204) THE WINGED TIGER HANDICAP – For Horses Rated 1-26 (About) 1100 Metres (2.00/2.03) : 14 runners

SUPER CHIC (Md Islam) planted and took no practical part in the race. The Starting Stall Certificate has been revoked by the Starter.

MY LADY LUCK (Vinay Jaiswal) and HURRICANE STORM (Bal Ramandeep) were slow to begin. App Rupal Singh, the rider of MODIFICATION, was fined a sum of Rs. 5,000/- for the indiscriminate use of the whip.

2nd RACE (205) THE AUNTY PIP HANDICAP – For Horses Rated 21-46, Rated 1-26 eligible, which have run at Kolkata having completed the course since 4th November, 2018 and have not won a race at any centre since that date – (About) 1100 Metres (2.30/2.33) : 14 runners

SCORPION QUEEN (Rajendra Singh) and DIAMOND HARBOUR (Mohit Singh) were fractious while being stalled.

An enquiry was held immediately after the running of the race with particular reference to the fall of SCARLET EMPEROR (App Aditya Kr. Jaiswal) passing the distance post. At the conclusion of the enquiry it was established that the fall was due to a severe cardiac arrest of ch g SCARLET EMPEROR. The 'ALL CLEAR' signal was ordered to be hoisted. App Aditya Kr. Jaiswal was given immediate medical attention.

Approaching the distance post ROYAL NEWS (Suraj Narredu) had to be checked by its rider and lost some ground when MONTECASINO (Ajeet Kumar) shifted 'outwards'. At a subsequent enquiry Jockey Ajeet Kumar was shown the CCTV replay of the race and fined a sum of Rs. 2,500/- for making no attempt to keep his mount on a straight path.

The Veterinary Officer reported that ROYAL NEWS returned bleeding from both nostrils. Tr. Shyam S Habbu was informed not to accept with his charge until certified fit by the Veterinary Officer.

3rd RACE (206) THE KINKAJOU PLATE – For Maiden Horses 3 years old only (About) 1100 Metres (3.00/3.10) : 14 runners

FEISTY (App P Vikram) whose left fore shoe was re-shod behind the starting gates was slow to begin. DECIDER (Ajeet Kumar), LUNA LUCINDA (Mohit Singh) and WIND CHASER (Afzal Khan) were fractious while being stalled.

ASMITA (Suraj Narredu, drawn 7) and LUNA LUCINDA (Mohit Singh, drawn 6) made contact with each other soon after the start.

4th RACE (207) THE PA BEAR HANDICAP – For Horses Rated 21-46, Rated 1-26 eligible – To be ridden by Jockeys of Indian Nationality (About) 1400 Metres (3.30/3.39) : 14 runners

CAIDEN (Afzal Khan), ALIEN (Mohit Singh) and FIREBURG (Vinay Jaiswal) were fractious while being stalled.

Jockey Hindu Singh, the rider of DAY FLOWER, reported that his leg slipped from the left stirrup iron while rounding the bend which he was able to regain after some distance.

5th RACE (208) THE ESQUIRE HANDICAP – For Horses Rated 41-66, Rated 21-46 eligible – To be ridden by Jockeys of Indian Nationality (About) 1400 Metres (4.00/4.11) : 11 runners

OTHELLO (Rajendra Singh) was slow to begin.

BANG BANG (App P Vikram) was inclined to run 'out' from about the 800 metres. Tr. Shafiq Khan was advised to take appropriate remedial measures.

The Veterinary Officer reported that CARPE NOCTEM returned bleeding from both nostrils. Tr. Javed Khan was informed not to accept his charge until certified fit by the Veterinary Officer.

6th RACE (209) THE KALIED CUP – For Horses Rated 61-86, Rated 41-66 eligible – To be ridden by Jockeys of Indian Nationality (About) 1200 Metres (4.30/4.3) : 12 runners

4th RACE (193) THE STAR OF ITALY HANDICAP – For Horses Rated 61-86, Rated 41-66 eligible (About) 1400 Metres (3.15/3.18) : 11 runners

At the conclusion of an enquiry which had been opened with particular reference to the interference received by APALACHEE (Suraj Narredu) and MYGRATOR (Akash Rajput) approaching the distance post, App P Vikram was interviewed by the Stewards. After due enquiry the Stewards found App P Vikram, the rider of MALANA, guilty of careless riding under Rule 161(i) in that he allowed his mount to shift 'outwards' when placing it under pressure which caused severe interference to APALACHEE and MYGRATOR. Consequently they decided to suspend App P Vikram from riding in races for the first two race days of the Calcutta Monsoon Meeting 2019, the date and day of which will be published in the Monsoon Prospectus 2019. The Apprentice was informed of his right to appeal.
