No entry shall be received for any race except upon condition that it shall be subject to the Rules of Racing of the Royal Calcutta Turf Club and the General Conditions as published in this Prospectus and that all disputes, claims and objections arising out of such entry and/or the start and/ or the running and/or the result of the race as in all other races under the Rules of this Club shall be referred to/decided by the Stewards and their decision shall be final.
2. Unless already registered under R C T C, R W I T C, M R C, B T C, H R C or Mys R C Rules, horses must be registered and rated with the Handicapper, R.C.T.C., otherwise entries will be refused.

EXCEPT WHERE OTHERWISE SPECIFIED NO HORSE SHALL BE ENTERED IN ANY RACES OTHER THAN THOSE FOR THE CLASS IN WHICH IT IS RATED BY THE HANDICAPPER, R C T C.

The list of entries shall be closed at the time appointed and no entry shall be admitted on any ground after the time except horses becoming eligible to enter after closing of entries for a handicap race only may be entered after the revised ratings are published provided such provision has been provided. For Terms races with a final entry clause, entries may also be accepted as advertised.
3. In the event of a handicap race, which is a Sweepstakes race, horses becoming eligible to enter after closing of entries may be entered by a certain date to be advertised on full payment of entry fee and / or forfeits. When a horse becomes ineligible to run in a race for which the entries have already closed, the entry fee already paid in such a case will be refunded.
4. The rating of a horse shall be determined by the Handicapper from time to time. Any appeal against his decision, must be made in writing to the Secretary of the meeting for reference to the Stewards of the Club.
5. The change in the rating of a horse in any race subsequent to the publication of handicaps for any other race for which such horse has entered, shall not be published before the Final Forfeits for that race.
6. **To qualify for entry, Horses must be rated atleast 2 days prior to the closing of entries by the Handicapper, R.C.T.C.** Such Horses which leave station to race at other centres, fresh ratings should be obtained from the Handicapper **R.C.T C** on their return to Kolkata. Applications for allotment of ratings under the R.C.T.C. Rules of Racing must state the date, rating, centre and where the horse has last raced. If the horse is unraced, the age and sex must be stated. Ratings will be issued only for horses that are in station.
7. No horse shall be entered in any race other than those for which it is eligible unless otherwise mentioned in the conditions of the race.
8. Horses which have raced at meetings other than those conducted under the **R.C.T.C.** Rules of Racing subsequent to the allotment of ratings by the Handicapper, **R.C.T.C.** must be re-rated by the Handicapper, **R.C.T.C.** prior to closing of entries for any Handicap Races under these Rules. Entries for any Handicap race for which application for allotment of rating has not been received, may be refused or cancelled.

9. In the event of a horse having raced at a Meeting other than the **R.C.T.C.** Rules of Racing subsequent to its having been entered for a Handicap Race under the R.C.T.C. Rules, the entries of such horse shall be void.
10. In the event of horses having raced at meetings other than the **R.C.T.C.** Rules of Racing subsequent to having been handicapped under the R.C.T.C. Rules, such Horses shall be withdrawn from the race even after having been Handicapped or Accepted.
11. **A fee of Rs. 2000/- per horse will be charged for the use of the outer portion of the Monsoon Track if and when made available for 'fast work'.**
12. Should circumstances arise which in the opinion of the Stewards, make it desirable; the date and time at which forfeits are advertised to fall due are liable to alterations after closing of entries.
13. a) Entries must be accompanied by a remittance for the full amount of such entries and shall state :-
 - i) Race
 - ii) Rating
 - iii) Owner's name.
 - iv) Colour, Age and Sex of Horse
 - v) Horse's name and Pedigree
 - vi) Trainer
- b) The Stewards, Royal Calcutta Turf Club have decided to strictly enforce the norms governing Sweepstakes/Classic Races in that all entries for the Sweepstakes/Classic Races must be accompanied by the requisite entry fee either by Cash/Bank Draft or local Cheque or with a Transfer Sheet to cover the entry fee.
14. All Entries must be signed by the Owner/Authorised agent failing which such entries are liable to be rejected (See Rule 83).
- a) Entries should be made in the requisite forms available with the Racing Department.
- b) Except where otherwise specified if in any race there are less than eight race worthy horses entered in bonafide separate interests the race will be at the option of the Stewards.

DIVISION OF RACES

15. a) A race may be divided only when the number of acceptors exceeds the required number for starting. However, in the event of there being more than one such race on a race day, the race with the maximum number of acceptors may only be divided while acceptors for each of the other races will be balloted out by drawing lots amongst the horses belonging to Owner/s (i.e. in the same colours) and thereafter, Trainer/s who have accepted the highest number of horses. If the number of horses eliminated is not sufficient, lots will be drawn again amongst the horses belonging to Owner/s (i.e. in the same colours) and Trainer/s who have accepted the next highest number of horses. This process will be continued till the required number of

horses is achieved. However, Owners and Trainers who have accepted more than one horse in a race, may exercise their priority of elimination and the same should be lodged in writing and placed in the scratching box before the time of scratchings for that day

b) **Safety Factor** – The maximum runners permitted in a race for the Calcutta Monsoon Meeting 2025 is 12. However, in all races advertised to be run from the distance of 1600 metres, the Maximum number of runners permitted is 8.

c) Notwithstanding the above, all division of races shall be at the sole discretion of the Stewards.

16. NO SWEEPSTAKES RACE SHALL BE DIVIDED EXCEPT WITH THE PERMISSION OF THE STEWARDS, RCTC.

17. Balloting out of horses in Sweepstakes Races:-

If the number of acceptors in Sweepstakes Races, at Final Forfeits, exceeds the number of horses which can safely be started at that distance, the horses will be rejected in the following order :-

Procedure for rejection of acceptors shall be based on :

- i) The aggregate value of all Stakes earned by the horse during the current Season and preceding two seasons. Horses having earned higher aggregate value will be accepted and after determining the required number of acceptors, the remaining horses having lower aggregate value will be rejected. If two or more horses are of equal low aggregate value the horse/s would be rejected by ballot.
 - ii) In case of Sweepstakes races confined to maidens, the rejection would be by ballot.
18. In all cases where a horse is rejected/balloted out, all entry fees and forfeits payable in respect of that horse shall be refundable. In case of a Sweepstakes race, only the final forfeit due from such horse/s shall be refundable.
- a) In the event of a walk-over (other than a Sweepstakes Race) only half the amount of Stakes payable to the winner will be given in addition to the Cup/ Trophy if any (See Rule 187).
 - b) The Stewards reserve the right to refuse to accept the tender of an entry and/or to cancel an accepted entry at any time without assigning a reason.
 - c) The Stewards reserve the right to amend or to alter the conditions of any race at any time before closing of entries.
 - d) The Stewards reserve the right to restrict a certain number of races for Jockeys of Indian Nationality.
19. Weights for Terms Races wherever applicable must be declared in writing to the Handicapper, RCTC not later than the date and time for final forfeits. Failure to comply with this will render the concerned person liable for disciplinary action.

In calculating the winnings, all stake money/prizes earned (whether in money or in nature of Cups & Trophies) actually credited to a winning horse, whether receivable by the owner and/ or any other person/s in connection

with the running of the horse under any recognised Turf Authority, shall be taken into account.

20. a) The Stewards reserve the right to cancel, at any stage, a race/race day, at their sole discretion should they be satisfied that the number of entries or acceptors are, in their opinion, insufficient for that race/ race day to be viable.

b) The Stewards reserve the right to amend or alter the conditions of any race at anytime before the entry closes or to frame additional races and to indicate any race or races to be ridden by Jockeys of Indian Nationality and Apprentices at the time of publication of acceptances.

21. All horses accepting, i.e., left in after the time for Final Forfeits must be declared to start unless prior permission for their withdrawal has been obtained from the Stewards. No horse shall be accepted to participate in more than one race on the same day and no horse shall be accepted to participate in more than one race when racing has been scheduled for consecutive days.

a) Unless otherwise specified, Starting Declarations for each race must be in the declaration box set apart for that race (at or before the appointed time, or if there is no such time, not later than 1200 hours on the day preceding the race).

IF, HOWEVER, BY AN ERROR, THE DECLARATION HAS BEEN PUT IN THE WRONG BOX, THE STEWARDS MAY AT THEIR DISCRETION PERMIT THE HORSE TO RUN, THE TRAINER/AUTHORISED AGENT MAY BE FINED A SUM FIXED BY THE STEWARDS OF THE CLUB FROM TIME TO TIME.

b) The declaration must be in writing and must state the name of the race, the name of the horse, weight to be carried and the name of the Jockey. Such declaration must be accompanied by the amount due for extra money for Horses not struck out, for the Jockey's fee for a losing mount, if not already paid and for any fees due. It shall also state if the horse is running shod or unshod, if the former, it shall state the description of shoes, plates or tips used. Omissions or errors in the Starting Declaration will render the owner or person making it subject to a fine at the discretion of the Stewards.

c) (It is mandatory for Owners/Trainers/Authorised Agents to comply with the R.C.T.C. Rules of Racing 110 & 126.) They should ensure that the jockeys fees as for a losing mount and all outstanding amounts due by the owner are paid up before the time of declaration to start. Owners are advised, in their own interest, to maintain their Accounts in credit. It is obligatory on the part of the Trainers to check up the accounts of the acceptors before lodging the Starting Declarations. The Stewards, R.C.T.C. will take a serious view of any non compliance of the above instructions and take disciplinary action against the persons concerned.

22. Colours must be declared with entries unless already registered with the Royal Calcutta Turf Club.

Unregistered colours must be declared in the Club's office at or prior to the time fixed for Final Forfeits and must be of the pattern as described in the regulations governing the registration of colours as published in the Racing Calendar. Such or other approved colours must be registered with the Royal Calcutta Turf Club when notification to do so has been issued, vide Rule 119; if there be more than one horse of any owner left in, in a race, a different coloured Cap must be declared for each horse. Every person running a horse in colours other than those registered or declared as above, will be fined in accordance with Rule 118 in respect of each horse so run. In the event of a person being unable to run a horse in colours as declared in the Race Card, the Jockey will wear 'ALL BLACK'. A set of these colours may be obtained from the Clerk of the Scales on a payment of Rs. 1000/-.

23. In all handicaps, a Winner of a race after the publication of weights to carry 5 kgs. extra; provided that the horse is otherwise eligible.
24. In all handicaps the lowest weight allotted shall not be less than 50 kgs. However, the Handicapper may frame his handicaps down to weights below the permitted lowest weight wherever necessary.
25. No horse shall carry more than 2 kg overweight in any race, except with the permission of the Stewards. Such permission must be obtained before the starting declaration box for such race is opened.
26. Horses which are not stationed at Kolcuta will not be handicapped except for Sweepstakes Races.
27. Owners/Trainers of outstation horses who intend to race them at this centre, must apply for stables well in advance and obtain permission in writing prior to the date of the race. Stables will be allotted at the discretion of the Stewards one week prior to the race and will have to be vacated within a week following the race.
28. Before a horse is allowed to start in a race for the first time under R.C.T.C. Rules of Racing, such horse must be produced before the Veterinary officer, R.C.T.C for identification.
29. The Stewards, RCTC have decided that all 'A' licensed trainers must have a minimum of 6 race worthy sound horses under their care failing which the defaulting Trainers would be reported to the Stewards for such action as deemed fit. Accordingly, Trainers are strongly advised to adhere to this stipulation.
30. Apprentice Allowance - An apprentice shall be entitled to claim same allowance specified under Rule 100(h) through out the day of racing as he/ she was entitled to claim at the beginning of that day.
31. a) **Calcutta based 8 years old horses Rated 81 & above which have been certified racing sound by the GM Veterinary Services, RCTC will be permitted to race in Kolkata till the conclusion of Calcutta Monsoon Meeting 2025.**
 b) **Horses rated "1" at the conclusion of the Calcutta Monsoon Meeting 2025 which have not placed 1st/2nd/3rd/4th/5th or 6th during the Calcutta Monsoon Meeting 2025 will have to vacate the RCTC premises at the conclusion of Calcutta Monsoon Meeting 2025.**

During the course of the Monsoon Meeting 2025 any horse/s rated "0" by the Handicapper, RCTC will have to vacate the RCTC premises immediately.

32. SCHEME FOR INWARD MOVEMENT OF HORSES

The Stewards, RCTC, are pleased to announce the following revised scheme for the Season 2025-26 in respect of inward movement of horses into RCTC which will come into force with immediate effect :-

A. 'A' licensed Trainers

1. Horses 5 years to 7 years old, Rated 15 & above at the centre where they last raced and which have placed 1st or 2nd or 3rd or 4th at least once since April 2023 are permitted to be brought into RCTC with immediate effect.
2. Three/Four year old horses are permitted to be brought in under this scheme provided they have a valid Starting Stall Certificate.
3. A stable entry fee of Rs. 5000/- per horse under the charge of 'A' licensed trainers will be charged to the owners on arrival of the horse into RCTC.
4. Trainers are eligible to stable NOT more than 70 horses (excluding 2 year olds during the Monsoon Meeting) and NOT more than 70 horses (including 2 year olds during the Cold Weather Season).
5. Owners of horses will be levied electricity charges @ Rs. 500/- per horse per month.

B. 'B' Licensed Trainers

Horses trained by 'B' licensed trainers are permitted to race during the Calcutta Racing Season 2025-26 as under:

- a. In Classic & Sweepstakes races.
- b. Horses 4 years to 7 years old, Rated 47 & above at the centre where they last raced and which have placed 1st or 2nd or 3rd or 4th at least once since April 2023.
- c. Three year old horses are also permitted to be brought in under this scheme provided they have a valid Starting Stall Certificate.
- d. Not more than 24 horses per 'B' licensed trainer, including horses entered for Sweepstakes/ Classic races will be permitted.
- e. 'B' licensed Trainers are permitted to bring in not more than eight (8) 2-year-olds within the above limit of 24 horses to the RCTC for racing at Kolkata for the Season 2025-2026.
- f. 'A' Stable entry fee of Rs 15,000 per horse under the charge of 'B' licensed trainers will be charged on arrival of the horse into RCTC premises.
- g. A charge of Rs. 5,000/- per horse per month to be levied towards development charges.
- h) A horse cannot be transferred from an 'A' licensed Trainer to a 'B' licensed Trainer during the course of the Season unless the horse has been sold to an owner training with the 'B' licensed Trainer.

- C. An owner can train maximum with two Trainers only including 'B' licensed Trainers. Only horses entered for Classics/Sweepstakes races are exempted from this Rule but such horses will not be allowed to race in ordinary Handicap races. Further, a third Trainer for an owner can be permitted only with express permission from the Stewards.
- D. All applications to be vetted by the Racing Department and the **Stewards reserve the right to reject any application without assigning any reason.**
33. Owners are eligible to stable not more than 60 horses (excluding 2-year olds) during the Calcutta Monsoon Meeting 2025 and 60 horses (including 2-year-olds) with effect from 1st November 2025.
34. Definition of an Outstation Horse - All horses under the charge of a 'B' licensed trainer will be considered as outstation horses.
- 35 Trainers taking leave of absence on Race Days will be required to submit their instructions to jockeys in writing, through their agents/representatives to the Clerk of the Scales prior to the start of the race. Trainers failing to do so will be fined such sum as stipulated by the Stewards.
36. The Stewards reserve the right to indicate any race/s in which Foreign Jockeys are eligible at the time of publication of Acceptances.
- 37 1% will be deducted from commissions earned (except in graded races) by Jockeys (including foreign Jockeys) and the proceeds will be paid directly to the Jockeys Association of India.
- 38 1% percent will be deducted from gross stake money of all races except classic & graded races for the season 2025-2026 to be credited to the Race Horse & Stable Employees Welfare Society towards administrative costs
- 39 5% of all stakes will be debited to owners of horses under the charge of 'B' Licensed Trainers and transferred to the account of Race Horse & Stable Employees Welfare Society towards the Gratuity Fund.
- 40 The Stewards of the Club shall have power at all time and from time to time to reduce or vary the stake money of any race/s or even cancel a race/ s even after publication/advertisement of the stake money of such race/s, if in the opinion of the Stewards of the Club it becomes necessary/expedient to do so on any ground whatsoever including non payment and/or part payment by a sponsor of the sponsorship amount dues agreed to be contributed for a sponsored race. The Stewards of the Club shall be entitled to give their decision in the matter in their absolute discretion as deemed fit which may include the reduction of stake money or cancellation of any race or races. No person shall be entitled to raise any dispute on the decision taken by the Stewards of the Club and all shall be bound by such decision.
41. The Stewards of the Club shall have the power, suo moto, to alter or modify or rescind any condition even after the publication.
- 42 The interpretation of any condition rest solely with the Stewards RCTC and their decision will be final and binding.
