

STIPENDIARY STEWARDS REPORT
CALCUTTA RACES
SUMMER MEETING, NINTH DAY, FRIDAY, 4th APRIL, 2025

No false rails.

Penetrometer Reading 2 cms

1st RACE (179) – THE SNOW FOREST HANDICAP – For Horses Rated 1-26, which have run at Kolkata having completed the course since Wednesday, 30th October, 2024 and have not won a race at any centre since that date – (About) 1200 Metres (2.30/2.30) : 7 runners

AMADEUS and MOGAMBO were slow to begin.

AMADEUS broke down passing the 600 metres and was eased up by its rider. On examination the gelding was found to have fractured its left fore fetlock joint and was euthanized on the morning of 5th April, 2025 on humanitarian grounds.

The Veterinary Officer reported that :-

- a) SWIFT LADY and WINSANGEL returned bleeding from their nostrils.
- b) MOGAMBO returned lame on left fore.

Trs. Shafiq Khan, Rutherford Alford and B Mahesh were advised not to accept with their respective charges until certified fit by the Veterinary Officer.

2nd RACE (180) THE CRADLE OF THE DEEP HANDICAP – For Horses Rated 41-66, Rated 21-46 eligible, which have run at Kolkata having completed the course since Wednesday, 30th October, 2024 and have not won a race at any centre since that date – To be ridden by Jockeys of Indian Nationality – (About) 1200 Metres (3.00/3.02) : 5 runners

SMASH SHOT, an acceptor in the above race, collapsed and died during the morning track work on 1st April, 2024, as such the name of the gelding was withdrawn from the race.

Jockey Imran Chisty (GIMMLER) reported that his mount was hanging out from about the bend and when asked for a final effort the horse had nothing much to offer, was noted.

The Veterinary Officer was requested to examine IVANHOE and GIMMLER and submit his reports. On examination both the horses were found to be trotting sound.

3rd RACE (181) THE TOROLOCO CUP – For Horses Rated 1-26 (About) 1400 Metres (3.30/3.32) : 7 runners

INGRID was difficult to load.

LAHINA which was very difficult to load, missed the jump. Tr. Sabeel Shariff was advised to give his charge adequate gate practice before accepting with it again.

PHENOMENAL LADY dropped out from about 200 metres, eased up by its rider and finished the race detached. The Veterinary Officer was requested to examine the filly and submit his report. On examination the filly was found to be trotting sound.

On the morning of 5th April, 2025 YUVI was examined by the Veterinary Officer and found to be lame on left hind. Tr. Vikash Jaiswal was advised not to accept with his charge until certified fit by the Veterinary Officer.

**4th RACE (182) THE ALASKAN HANDICAP – For Horses Rated 41-66, Rated 21-46 eligible
- To be ridden by Jockeys of Indian Nationality (NO WHIPS ALLOWED) (About) 1400
Metres (4.00/4.01) : 8 runners**

ALDILA was slow to begin.

CELTIC HERLEQUIN reared up as the start was effected losing about 6 - 7 lengths at the start, thereafter finished the race detached. The Starting Stall Certificate has been revoked by the Starter.

CYRENAICA jumped awkwardly outwards on to N R I FANTASY.

Soon after the jump CRISTALDO came inwards on to KIND OF MAGIC and thereafter bumping on to HAPPY MORNING.

OH MY DARLING denied a clear run passing the 400 metres.

**5th RACE (183) THE ROYAL MANTLE HANDICAP – For Horses Rated 21-46, Rated 1-26
eligible – To be ridden by Jockeys of Indian Nationality (About) 1100 Metres (4.30/4.32) : 14
runners**

CRISTALDO ran in emergency colours “All Black” as the trainer failed to produce the registered colours for the gelding. Tr. B Mahesh was charged a sum of Rs. 500/- for the same and fined a sum of Rs. 1,000/- for the lapse.

EMBANKMENT jumped out awkwardly.

Jockey Vinay Jaiswal (HAPPY MORNING) reported that he lost his right stirrup iron at about the 600 metres and he could not ride out his mount to complete advantage, was noted.

At about 1000 metres CRISTALDO stumbled after being squeezed for space between HAPPY MORNING and THREE LITTLE WORDS.

**6th RACE (184) THE POLICE CUP – For Horses Rated 61-86, Rated 41-66 eligible (About)
1200 Metres (5.00/5.02) : 8 runners**

SIR BAFFERT was slow to begin losing approximately 2 – 3 lengths at the start.

RODRIGO eased up passing the 350 metres.. On examination the gelding was found to be trotting sound.

The Veterinary Officer reported that KAY STAR returned with a mouth injury.

**7th RACE (185) THE ANGELES HANDICAP – For Horses Rated 21-46, Rated 1-26 eligible –
To be ridden by Jockeys of Indian Nationality (About) 1600 Metres (5.30/5.30) : 10 runners**

MULTISTARRER which was fractious in its stall, missed the jump.

SPORTING TRAINING and FLOW ME missed the jump.
