WINTER MEETING, FIRST DAY, SATURDAY, 1st JANUARY, 2022

1st RACE (49) THE RETAINED ASSET HANDICAP – For Horses Rated 1-26 (About) 1200 Metres (12.00/12.02) : 9 runners

CAPE TANAROS (Neeraj Rawal) was extremely difficult to load. Tr. Aashay Doctor was advised to give his charge adequate gate practice before accepting with it again.

FERGUS (Vinay Jaiswal) which was difficult to load, was fractious in its stall.

REWRITE THE STARS (Arman Khan) was difficult to load.

BAYEZID (App Rupal Singh) which was fractious in its stall, was slow to begin.

MYSTIC PRINCE (App Hasib Alam) was slow to begin.

BAYEZID (App Rupal Singh) trailed the field and finished the race as such. Tr. Jasbir Singh was advised not to accept with his charge until it was capable of a better performance.

2nd RACE (50) THE ACCALIA HANDICAP DIV I - For Horses Rated 21-46, Rated 1-26 eligible (About) 1100 Metres (12.30/12.31) : 8 runners

KHAMSIN (Neeraj Rawal) which arrived late to the start thereby delaying the proceedings of the race, was slow to begin. Tr. Ms. Arti Doctor was advised to ensure that her charge arrives on time in future.

The surcingle used on b g CLIFFS OF CAPRI (Shezad Khan) was changed at the starting gates as the previous was loose and the gelding was slow to begin.

ASHWAMEGH (App P Tejeshwar) which was fractious in its stall, was slow to begin.

PROPERLY POSH (App Sujit Kr Paswan) was observed to be hanging in right through the final straight. Tr. Shafiq Khan was advised to take appropriate remedial measures.

The Veterinary Officer reported that MYSTIC STAR (Md Islam) returned bleeding from its nostrils. Tr. Manvendra Singh was informed not to accept with his charge until certified fit by the Veterinary Officer.

3rd RACE (51) THE ACCALIA HANDICAP DIV II – For Horses Rated 21-46, Rated 1-26 eligible (About) 1100 Metres (1.00/1.01) : 8 runners

BERLUTI (Saddam Hussain) was fractious to be stalled.

FOR EVERMORE (Hindu Singh) was difficult to load.

INDIAN STAR (Asghar) was slow to begin.

NANDINI'S PET (App Hasib Alam) drifted outwards from about the distance post. App Hasib Alam was advised to exercise greater control over his mounts in future.

Jockey Asghar, the rider of INDIAN STAR, was fined a sum of Rs. 3,000/- for the indifferent handling of his mount through out the race.

Jockey Vinay Jaiswal, the rider of MR. BATOLABAAZ, was reprimanded for unnecessarily travelling wide in the middle stages of the race.

The Veterinary Officer reported that BERLUTI returned lame on left hind. Tr. Shafiq Khan was informed not to accept with his charge until certified fit by the Veterinary Officer.

4th RACE (52) THE betindiaraces.com RCTC GOLD VASE – For Horses Rated 81 & above, Rated 61-86 eligible (About) 2200 Metres (1.30/1.30) : 4 runners

RENO STAR (Abhay Singh) jumped awkwardly from the gates.

5th RACE (53) THE 91.9 FRIENDS FM CUP – For Horses Rated 21-46, Rated 1-26 eligible (About) 2000 Metres (2.00/2.06) : 12 runners

THE INDICATOR (N S Parmar) was slow to begin losing approximately 3 to 4 lengths at the start.

Jockey Chethan Gowda, the rider of VANGUARD, was fined a sum of Rs. 3,000/- for excessive use of the whip on his mount (1st infringement).

6th RACE (54) THE TELEGRAPH CUP – For Horses Rated 41-66, Rated 21-46 eligible (About) 1100 Metres (2.30/2.39) : 9 runners

MEMORABLE MEMORIES (App Sujit Kr Paswan) and WHISPERING GRASS (N S Parmar) were difficult to load.

LOUBOUTIN (App Rupal Singh) was extremely fractious in its stall.

LEGENDARY STRIKER (C S Jodha) was hanging in during the concluding stages of the race.

7th RACE (55) THE INDIAN PRODUCE STAKES – For Horses 3 years old only (About) 1200 Metres (3.00/3.20) : 11 runners

TOO MUCH POLITICS (Saddam Hussain) was extremely fractious to load. Tr. Vikash Jaiswal was advised to give his charge adequate gate practice before accepting with it again.

SONATA (Neeraj Rawal) was extremely difficult to load and was hanging out from about the 800 metres of the race. Tr. Bharath Singh was advised to give his charge adequate gate practice before accepting with it again.

KUNAL'S BAGHEERA (Shailesh Shinde) and MANDELA (Nikhil Naidu) were difficult to load.

ODIN (Sujit Kr Paswan) was fractious to be stalled as well as inside its stall.

LEONARDO (N S Parmar) was slow to begin.

8th RACE (56) THE ROYAL MANTLE HANDICAP – For Horses Rated 41-66, Rated 21-46 eligible (About) 1400 Metres (3.30/3.59) : 9 runners

LUMINOUS (Hindu Singh) was extremely fractious in its stall. The mare was taken out from its stall, examined by the Veterinary Officer, declared fit to race and was re-stalled. In view of its behaviour Tr. Vijay Singh was advised not to accept with his charge until shown to the satisfaction of the starter in a barrier trial during the hours of morning track work.

SHERWIN (Abhay Singh) was fractious in its stall.

WHO DARES WINS (C S Jodha) was slow to begin.

FOOL PROOF (Saddam Hussain) stood flat footed losing approximately 6 to 7 lengths at the start. Tr. Vikash Jaiswal was advised not to accept with his charge until shown to the satisfaction of the Stipendiary Steward in a barrier trial during the hours of morning track work.

9th RACE (57) THE ANDROPOV HANDICAP – For Horses Rated 61-86, Rated 41-66 eligible (About) 1400 Metres (4.00/4.39) : 11 runners

KIMAYA (P Ajeeth Kumar) was fractious in its stall.

CLETUS (Hindu Singh) was slow to begin.
