

STIPENDIARY STEWARDS REPORT

CALCUTTA RACES

MONSOON MEETING, SIXTH DAY, WEDNESDAY, 9th SEPTEMBER, 2026

No false rails

Penetrometer Reading 3.5 cms

1st RACE (35) THE IMPERIAL POWER HANDICAP – For Horses Rated 61-86, Rated 41-66 eligible (About) 2000 Metres (2.00/2.03) : 5 runners

Jockey A Ashhad Asbar (GOLDEN GLOW) was warned for presenting himself late for weighing-out and advised to be more careful in future.

Tr. Sabeel Shariff was warned for the late arrival of his charge GOLDEN GLOW to the parade ring and informed that further repetition would attract disciplinary action.

ZARAK (Vishal N Bunde) was eased up by its rider passing the 400 metres. Tr. S Waheed was advised not to accept with his charge until it was capable of a better performance.

Vet's report :

TOGO returned lame on its left fore after the race. Tr. Neil Darashah was advised not to accept with his charge until certified fit by the Veterinary Officer.

2nd RACE (36) THE FREE ENERGY CUP – For Horses Rated 21-46, Rated 1-26 eligible – To be ridden by Jockeys of Indian Nationality (About) 1800 Metres (2.30/2.31) : 4 runners

Tr. Vikash Jaiswal (CASCADE) was fined a sum of Rs. 10,000/- for failing to follow the laid down procedure for horses being led to the start.

Jockey A Sandesh (STORMCHASER) reported that his mount drifted out when placed under pressure during the concluding stages of the race in spite of his best efforts, was noted. The Jockey further reported that he lost his whip in the final 75 metres of the race when Jockey Yash Narredu accidentally struck his whip.

3rd RACE (37) THE IMPERIAL STRIDE HANDICAP – For Horses Rated 1-26 – To be ridden by Jockeys of Indian Nationality (About) 1100 Metres (3.00/3.03) : 9 runners

DIAMOND GOLD was fractious in its stall.

GODSEND DIVINE and SOUL AQUARIAN were slow to begin.

A WINK ANNDA SMILE dropped out from about the final 200 metres of the race and was eased up by its rider. Tr. Rutherford Alford was advised not to accept with his charge until capable of a better performance.

Jockey Md Azharuddin (CASHABAN) was fined a sum of Rs. 3,000/- for excessive use of the whip (1st infringement).

Vet's report :

SEONA and A WINK ANNDA SMILE were examined and no abnormalities were noticed.

4th RACE (38) THE EASTERN STAR HANDICAP – For Horses Rated 41-66, Rated 21-46 eligible (About) 1100 Metres (3.30/3.38) : 12 runners

CASH YOUR LUCK was very reluctant on way to the start thereby delaying the proceedings of the race. Further, the mare finished the race detached from the field. Tr. Sabeel Shariff was advised to ensure that his charges arrive to the start on time and not to accept with CASH YOUR LUCK until capable of a better performance.

MOST AND MORE (Imran Chisty) jumped outwards from its stall onto SIR WINSTON.

Approaching the 800 metres MOST AND MORE (Imran Chisty) was tightened and had to be checked by its rider when CORTADO (P Tejeshwar) shifted inwards. Jockey P Tejeshwar was advised to exercise greater

control over his mounts in future.

SUPERLATIVE (Md Azharuddin) fly jumped out from the gates.

QUEEN ANULA was slow to begin losing 3 – 4 lengths at the start. Tr. V Ajith Kumar was advised not to accept with his charge until shown to the satisfaction of the Starter in a barrier trial.

Jockey Vinay Jaiswal (HEER) reported that the cross nose band used on his mount broke during the running of the race, was noted. Tr. Ajay Sharma was advised to be careful in this regard.

Vet's report :

1. CASH YOUR LUCK was examined and no abnormalities were noticed.
2. MOST AND MORE returned with left nostril injury.

5th RACE (39) THE CALCUTTA COLTS TRIAL STAKES – For Indian Colts & Geldings 3 years old only (About) 1400 Metres (4.00/4.06) : 4 runners

Jockey Suraj Narredu (LUTHER) was fined a sum of Rs. 3,000/- for excessive use of the whip (1st infringement).

Vet's report :

CIELO sustained a tooth injury in the saddling enclosure, was examined and certified fit to race.

6th RACE (40) THE ARGIANO HANDICAP DIV I – For Horses Rated 21-46, Rated 1-26 eligible – To be ridden by Jockeys of Indian Nationality (About) 1200 Metres (4.30/4.35) : 9 runners

Tr. Aashay Doctor was warned for the late arrival of his charge PEABERRY to the start thereby delaying the proceedings of the race. The Trainer was further advised to ensure that his charges arrive on time in future.

MIDNIGHT BLUE and REAL HAPPINESS arrived late to the start thereby delaying the proceedings of the race. As Trs. Rajesh Narredu and Sabeel Shariff had earlier been warned for late arrival of their charges, they have now been fined a sum of Rs. 2,000/- each for the same.

DUBAI RULER and SPORTING TRAINER were slow to begin.

Jockeys P Tejeshwar (SPORTING TRAINER) and Arman Khan (REAL HAPPINESS) were fined a sum of Rs. 3,000/- each for excessive use of the whips on their respective mounts (1st infringement).

7th RACE (41) THE ARGIANO HANDICAP DIV II – For Horses Rated 21-46, Rated 1-26 eligible – To be ridden by Jockeys of Indian Nationality (About) 1200 Metres (5.00/5.13) : 9 runners

PRINCESS PEACH stumbled on jump out.

CACHE was slow to begin.

ITALIAN GOLD arrived late to the start.

Tr. Shafiq Khan, the trainer of ITALIAN GOLD which is known to be reluctant to go to the start, was advised to school his charge better and ensure that his charges reach the start on time.

Jockey A Ashhad Asbar (SASEKA) was fined a sum of Rs.5,000/- for tightening TYCOONIST and GRENOBLE on his inside about 100 metres after the start.

Vet's report :

PRINCESS PEACH returned with right nostril injury.

1. **Breath Analyser Test** -Breath analyser tests in respect of Jockeys A Ashhad Asbar, Arman Khan, Sah Farid Ansari and Md Azharuddin were carried out and found to be clear.

7th RACE (34) THE SCRUPLES HANDICAP DIV II – For Horses Rated 21-46, Rated 1-26 eligible – To be ridden by Jockeys of Indian Nationality (NO WHIPS ALLOWED) (About) 1100 Metres (5.00/5.05) : 5 runners

A Stewards enquiry was held after the last race on 9th September, 2026 into the running and riding of DRAMATIC, trained by Mr. Shyam S Habbu and ridden by Jockey Imran Chisty. The Stewards having considered the explanations tendered by Jockey Imran Chisty and Tr. Shyam S Habbu, the opinion expressed by the Stipendiary Stewards, acting on their own observations of the race and not being satisfied with the explanations tendered by Jockey Imran Chisty, found him guilty of unsatisfactory riding under Rule 159(b) of RCTC Rules of Racing in that he failed to persevere with his mount with sufficient vigour during the final 200 metres of the race and decided to suspend him from riding in races from 28th October, 2026 to 28th November, 2026 (both days inclusive). The Jockey was informed of his right to appeal.
